We want to know why it is important to you and should be important to the community. Please also submit your speech in writing as well as filling out the attached form.

Eligibility:

- Competition is opened to North Bay teens, ages 16-20 only
- Applicants must be enrolled in a high school, college or university, who wish to continue their post-secondary education
- Must live in Marin, Sonoma, or Napa county

Prizes:

First place winner will win the opportunity to deliver the Keynote Speech at our Leaders of the North Bay Awards luncheon which showcases incredible leaders in our community. You will also win a scholarship of \$5,000 and the opportunity to have one-on-one leadership and speech coaching with our President and CEO, Joanne Webster. Two complimentary tickets to the awards luncheon will be provided. Winner must be able to come to the awards luncheon on May 16, 2024.

One runner up will receive \$1,000 scholarship. In addition to the winner and runner ups, two additional finalists will be granted a \$500 scholarship.
